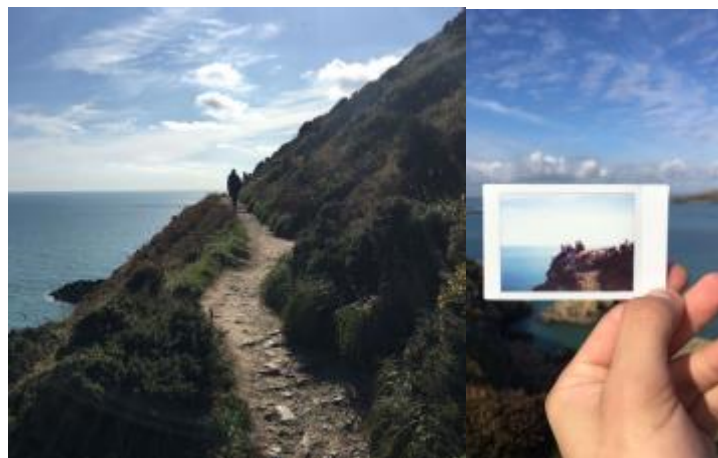


Guinness
